

THE STRONG EJECTION REFLEX (SER)

MANIFESTATIONS

The strong ejection reflex, or SER, is a powerful ejection of milk with a very fast flow that is different from one person to another.

For the mother

Possible nipple pain from the baby trying to reduce milk flow by:

- Pulling on the nipple
- Pinching the lips together
- Biting with the gums

For the baby

- Often uncomfortable or agitated during feedings
- Withdraws from breast frequently, swallows air and may choke
- Refuses breast or shortens feeding (may affect weight gain)
- Digestive problems such as:
 - Stomach pain
 - Gas
 - Regurgitation more numerous or voluminous
 - Stools can be different
