

# DYSPHORIC MILK EJECTION REFLEX (D-MER)

- **Mood disturbance and unpleasant emotions felt when milk enters the breast (known as the ejection reflex)**
- **Dysphoric feeling diminishes as feeding progresses, then disappears between feeds**
- **Can occur when :**
  - **Baby is at the breast (at the first ejection reflex or every time)**
  - **Expression of milk**
  - **Spontaneous ejection reflex**
  - **Nipple stimulation**

## Good to know

- **Probably due to hormonal reaction (drop in dopamine during ejection reflex)**

  - **Post-partum depression**
  - **Mood disorder**
  - **Psychological aversion to breastfeeding**
